LISTING OF S&P/TSE SECTORIAL INDEX FUTURES CONTRACTS

Bourse de Montréal Inc. («the Bourse») intends to list on **Monday, April 29, 2002** futures contracts on the following four S&P/TSE sectorial indices:

- S&P/TSE Canadian Information Technology Index (SXH)
- S&P/TSE Canadian Energy Index (SXY)
- S&P/TSE Canadian Financials Index (SXB)
- S&P/TSE Canadian Gold Index (SXA)

Herein enclosed are the **contract specifications** for the S&P/TSE sectorial index futures. Rules Six and Fifteen of the Bourse, which relate to contract specifications, have been simplified in order to permit the Bourse to adopt flexible contract sizes and price fluctuation units for futures and options contracts on S&P/TSE indices and share futures contracts. Please note that approved participants will be authorized to execute crosses on sectorial index futures contracts if the eligible portion is greater than 100 contracts. In addition, in order to account for the specific nature, which relates to the margin and capital requirements of stock index products, Rules Seven, Eleven and Fifteen of the Bourse have been amended. These new rules will be effective on April 29, 2002.

The **initial margin requirements** for each S&P/TSE sectorial index futures contract are described below:
